

**Father Lopez Catholic High School
Athletic Booster Club
Meeting Minutes for October 18, 2011**

The meeting was called to order at 6:07 p.m. by Jeff Hawk and opened with prayer.

The September meeting minutes were distributed and reviewed. Jeanette Larsen made motion to accept the minutes which was seconded by Jose Rivera. The minutes were approved.

Jeff Hawk discussed the monthly financial report. Clarification will be obtained regarding the account balance.

Athletic Department Update: Jose Fernandez commended the outstanding effort by the volleyball team. Jeff Hawk asked Jose if the teams and coaches were coordinating with him regarding their fundraising. Jeff also asked about the Jimmy Sullivan sponsors and if there would be a similar sponsorship package for basketball and soccer families. Jose stated that he will be meeting with Trevor Berryhill to tailor a package for the winter season. Jose also discussed the matching gift offer that is in effect until the end of this month.

John Restuccia gave a report from the golf tournament. There were thirty-six hole sponsors and the hole signs were printed for free. There were seventy-two golfers. A net "net" amount raised is at approximately \$6200. There were five foursomes from the Jimmy Sullivan sponsor package that decreased the amount raised from teams.

John also discussed concessions. There needs to be a review of inventory, costs and deposits to determine the amount that has been raised so far.

Monica MacIntyre had to leave the meeting at this point and the minutes were recorded by Jennifer Sisk in her absence.

The C2C website has not been available according to John McFarland. Jose Fernandez will check into the problem and have it up and running soon.

John Restuccia complimented the alumni reception tent. He felt it was very successful and a great way to welcome the alumni back on campus. Jose Fernandez added that he and Monica are looking into having another alumni tent on December 9th during the girls and boys basketball games against Masters Academy. Jose suggested having the tent again next year; however maybe include a bounce house for the kids to make it more family friendly. Discussion about the location of the tent and date to have homecoming continued. John McFarland asked if there were plans for an alumni basketball game and baseball game. Jeff replied that the Alumni and Friends baseball

game will be the first weekend in January. The suggestion of having an alumni night during Friday night basketball and then having a reception the next day was discussed. The consensus was that we need to continue finding ways to bring the alumni back to the campus and get them involved.

Jeanette Larsen gave report about the Christmas tree fundraiser. The volunteers have been handing out the flyers at the different parishes after the masses. She stated that there is a need for more help. The trees will be delivered to the school on Sunday morning, November 27th, and will be ready for pick up/delivery from 1:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. She is going to need many volunteers on that day. Jeanette also asked for all the members to send the flyers out through their personal e-mail address lists. The next committee meeting will be on November 16th following the Booster Club meeting.

Jeff Hawk told the members that there are already five or six people signed up to volunteer for the Bethune Cookman University homecoming overflow parking. He said that we will have to charge what BCU and the city are charging across the street. He asked for more people to sign up to volunteer. He also needs to schedule a trash clean up.

Jordan Clancy gave a presentation about the sport of lacrosse. It is the fastest growing sport at the youth level today. The first day of practice is January 30th.

Jennifer Sisk suggested a fundraising opportunity involving fun pasta and asked if anyone was interested.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m. The next monthly meeting will be on Wednesday, November 16, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the school Media Center.
