

Prom Rules and Regulations

Behavior Guidelines.

- All Father Lopez school rules found in the code of conduct apply.
- While at the dance, any behaviors deemed inappropriate by the chaperones will not be tolerated. (ex: unacceptable dancing, sitting on each other laps, or grinding...)
- Alcohol, drug, and tobacco products are not to be used or possessed before, during, or after the dance.
- Students must arrive to the Prom Dance by 9:00 pm.
- Once admitted, all individuals must remain at the dance until 11:00 pm.

Dress Code

- This is a formal event; all students must be dressed appropriately.
- Formal dress is required.
- Students bringing a guest from another school are responsible for making sure their guest is familiar with the guidelines and that they behave appropriately during the dance.
- All students requesting to bring a guest from another school must submit a guest request form to the Main Office by Monday March 29th. Forms must be filled out by the guest's school.
- Guest request forms are available from Main Office
- All guests must have a photo ID to present in order to be admitted to the dance.

Girls

No bare midriffs or revealing material.

No slits past 3 inches above the knee

No backs lower than 2 inches below your bra line.

No cleavage may be showing.

Dress must be modest in nature and allow adequate coverage.

Dress length must be at least finger- tip length.

Dress shoes.

***Dresses may shift as you dance, please be sure you take that in to account when selecting a dress.

Boys

Dress shirt and tie are required.

Dress pants required.

No cargo pants or jeans.

No sneakers.

Must be clean shaven.

Dress shoes required.

No earrings.

Failure to comply with the dress code or regulations will result in, refusal of admission, a phone call home to parents to pick up their child, and possible disciplinary actions. The administration reserves the right to determine whether or not a student is appropriately dressed and to determine the appropriateness of student dancing.
