## SUMMA CUM LAUDE PROGRAM

Summa Cum Laude offers a special four-year honors program for our advanced college-bound students. Graduates of the program receive a Summa Cum Laude Diploma.

## GRADING SYSTEM

The Father Lopez Catholic High School grading system is based on a 4.0 scale (weighted). Honors courses earn an extra 0.5 quality point, AP and Dual Enrollment courses earn an extra 1.0 quality point. The lowest passing grade is a D.

## STATISTICS

Over the past 10 years, 100% of our graduating seniors were accepted to colleges and universities! In the class of 2008, 82 % were accepted to four-year schools, while 18 % chose two-year schools.

In 2008, 68 graduates were offered over \$3.5 million in scholarships to some of the most prestigious four-year colleges in America. Of these, 72 % received a Florida Bright Futures Scholarship.

The class of 2008 completed 8936 community service hours during their 4 years at Father Lopez.
