The PSAT is administered in classrooms at Father Lopez. We will serve everyone a free breakfast to give you some brain food prior to the test. Dismissal will be at 12:00pm. Please arrive to school at the normal time.

Do I have to register to take the PSAT?

How do I get my scores?

Scores are delivered to the school in December. We will hold a parent meeting on December 14 at 6:00pm to deliver the scores and show you and your parents how to interpret them. You will also see your scores in your math and English classes, where your teachers will go over your problem areas in detail.

Who takes the HSPT?

All entering 9th graders take it prior to beginning their freshman year. They will take the test again in the spring semester so that we can monitor overall progress and learning gains.

When is the HSPT administered?

Current 9th graders will take the HSPT for the second time on April 12, 2010 from 7:40 to 11:00am during the school day.

Where do I take the HSPT?

This test is administered at Father Lopez.

How do I register to take the HSPT?

Incoming 9th graders should contact the main office at 386-253-5213 to schedule the test. There is a \$25 fee in December, and a \$50 fee thereafter.

Current 9th graders will be registered by the school and there is no fee.

How do I get my scores?

Scores for incoming 9th graders will be provided at individual scheduling meetings starting in March.

Scores for current 9th graders are not provided unless there is a problem. The data is used in school improvement planning, and will be reported as a whole group.
