Tuition Schedule for 2011-2012

I. Tuition for school year 2011/2012:

\$9,300 Catholic

\$9,800 Non-Catholic

→ **Income-based scholarships are available and awarded by the school administration within the following tiers:**

<u>Income level</u>	<u>Scholarship Amount</u>	<u>Adjusted Catholic Tuition</u>	<u>Adjusted Non-Catholic Tuition</u>
\$75,000 or less	\$2,800	\$6,500	\$7,000
\$75k to \$100k	\$1,800	\$7,500	\$8,000
\$100k to \$125k	\$800	\$8,500	\$9,000

[SMART financial verification required, for eligibility]

II. **There will be a family discount of \$1,000 per sibling for each student enrolled at FLCHS. This discount is available only while more than one student is attending.**

III. **The top two students from the feeder schools* (as identified by that school's principal) are awarded a scholarship (4-year award) as follows:**

Top performing graduate - \$1,000 scholarship

#2 performing graduate - \$500 scholarship

IV. **Additional tuition assistance may be available; a SMART application must be completed to be eligible for consideration.**

V. **Those not receiving income-based scholarships or tuition assistance are guaranteed that tuition will not increase by more than 3% annually for each student during their time at Lopez.**

Discounts and scholarships described in categories II and/or III will be applied prior to income-based scholarships and/or tuition assistance. All income-based scholarship and tuition assistance requests will require a completed SMART application to be eligible for consideration.

*Father Lopez eligible feeder schools as described in category III are as follows: All Souls Catholic School, Basilica School of St. Paul, Lourdes Academy, Sacred Heart Catholic School, St. Barnabas Episcopal School, St. Brendan Catholic School, St. James Episcopal School, and St. Peter Catholic School.
